SAMPLE LESSONS PLANS FOR A STRUGGLING READER

Sample Lesson Plans for a Grade 4 student with profound dyslexia (far below average - not even at a kindergarten level), low working memory and processing speed (<5th percentile), and some strengths (memory for related information).

- Lessons went from February June, and then started up again at the end of September (Grade 5), at which time this student said, 'I think this is the only thing that can help me'. The lessons are challenging for him, but he comes willingly and works VERY hard because he knows it is helping.
- He is now thriving and moving along at a regular pace, although still needs help to blend with more automaticity. He found "sounding out in his head" before saying it out loud to be an effective strategy.
- Note that these lesson plans were generated from other lesson plans from other students who had varying learning needs/abilities, and so you will see some more advanced spelling patterns in these lesson plans that I may or may not have covered with this particular student.
- I often will not cover every word or sentence there is rarely time.
- If there is a word in a sentence I have not taught them yet, I just say, "I haven't taught you this yet, but..." (then explain, and print for them to copy).



Note: This is where we get going. I got through the whole lesson. On the PAST TEST, he scored 5/10 on level D2. He is getting to know the vowels and why they are important. As it is important to make sure he experiences 95-99% success, we are still working on tall sticks – this has been challenging. I have noticed his extreme challenges with memory & word retrieval. He calls the long vowel sounds the 'straight' sounds. I usually put activities I want to do in RED on the lesson plan. But there is rarely enough time to cover everything – even what is only in red.
